One suggestion was to combine it with the Bolton Valley 5K to Benefit Vermont Adaptive Ski & Sports.

Deb also asked Paul and Ethan if they had any suggestions for an appreciation event for all the volunteers and staff of the Town of Bolton. This generated discussion that it could be combined with the Bolton Market Day event and made a community day. One suggestion for the renaming of the event was Bolton Community Fair.

It was decided that the ERC would meet with Paul and Ethan and hopefully Bolton Valley and Vermont Adaptive on Wednesday, November 9, to discuss the possibility of having a combined event.
