Bolton Potholes

The VT River Conservancy staff informed the CC that they would like to hold two public meetings regarding their interest in the Pot Holes. The first meeting would serve as an initial indicator of public interest and concern regarding the project. The second meeting would aim to address the input gathered from the first meeting in the form of an initial conservation plan.

Bolton Valley Nordic

CC members were informed that the Select Board had approved the project and that the \$800k VHCB grant had been secured. The next phase of the project would be the public fundraising component.

Long Trail Bridge

Several members voiced concern about proposed parking areas that were thought to be part of the GMC's plan. A letter previously received from the GMC addressed many of these concerns. The letter would be distributed to CC members for review.

Preston Pond

The Preston Pond Management Committee proposed a number of meetings over the summer months, each with a different theme. CC members offered that the majority of the meetings should be held in an indoor setting, reserving one or two of the meetings for focused field visits. CC members discussed arranging a volunteer workday to address known trail issues.
